First edition. The most important contribution to economic analysis of the author, a reformulation of the classical doctrines of value, labour and capital. Cairnes, professor of political economy in Dublin, Galway and London, friend and critic of John Stuart Mill, has been described as 'the last of the classical economists'. Schumpeter records that after Mill's death in 1873 Cairnes was considered England's first scientific economist, but he adds that Cairnes failed in appreciating the new insights in the theory of value developed by Jevons. \*Einaudi 788. First (only) edition. 'Etude des propriétés et du rôle économique et social du clergé; l'auteur critique le haut clergé et les pauvres, mais n'est pas anticlérical (peut-être est-il lui-même prêtre). First edition of the first economic work of the author. Gioja studied theology, mathematics, economics and statistics, to which last he applied himself steadily. Initially a catholic priest he became an active participant in the turbulent political life in Italy in his time and held various positions, at the time of publication of the present book that of historiographer of Cisalpina, later a.o. that of chief statistician of Milan. He became a dedicated writer of books on a wide range of subjects, of which his best known are his *Nuovo prospetto delle scienze economiche* published in 6 volumes in 1815-17. Gioja's main contribution to the development of economic analysis is his principle of association and of division of work as the attempt to obtain the maximum product with the minimum expenditure of effort, 'justly considering its advantages a cause of improvement in production'. Schumpeter notes that his work may be described 'best as an attempt to rewrite the *Wealth of nations* from the standpoint of the united Italy he visualized'. Yet he also remarks that Gioja's name should 'in fact be coupled' with that of Charles Babbage, who 'in some points recognized the priority of Gioja'.

First edition. A refutation of Malthus' *Essay on the principle of population*, in which Godwin sought to prove that Malthus' thesis that population increases geometrically whereas subsistence increases only arithmetically, and that hence attempts to improve the condition of the lower classes by the increasing of food production would be in vain. Godwin investigates the course of the population in Europe, Asia, Africa and the America's in ancient and modern times, and concludes that population did not increase in all cases and that reproduction decreases with improving standards of living. Godwin, 'the first and greatest exponent of philosophical anarchism' believed in the perfectibility of man, if only social and political institutions would enable this.

The most important scientific book of the author which has been marked as one of the best textbooks of his time 'covering in a very systematic way historical, theoretical, organizational and political issues'. It went through six editions and was also translated into English. Second edition. An important contribution to the acceptance of Smithian economics in Germany.

German economics was dominated by obsolete cameralist opinions until the end of the eighteenth century and Smithian ideas did not experience much enthusiasm, though a German translation of the *Wealth of nations* had appeared already in 1776/78. It was not before the beginning of the nineteenth century that Smithianism was adapted by economists like Hufeland, Lueder, Sartorius and Jakob.

Schumpeter notes that 'this was in fact more natural for them than had been the initial resistance because ... their own ideas had been moving on similar lines for many years before that'.

The principal economic work of the author, an eminent German jurist and popular professor in Jena where he taught natural law following Kantian principles. He later moved to Würzburg and Landshut.

A second edition appeared in 1815. First published in 1807, both editions are rare and seldomly offered.

The second volume deals with money and seems particularly interesting; it was republished in 1819 with the title *Die Lehre vom Gelde und Geldumlaufe*.

First edition. A contribution to the application of mathematics to demographical problems. Knapp was professor in Leipzig and Strassburg, one of the leading figures of German *Katheder* socialism and among the founders of the *Verein für Sozialpolitik*. His early work was chiefly concerned with statistics and agricultural economics and only later he turned to monetary theory (*Staatliche Theorie des Geldes* 1905). The present volume is divided into three parts, of which the first part is a 'mathematical exposition of the theory with due regard to the unsteadiness of functions'. The second part treats the history of population theory (with discussions of Graunt, Halley, Kersseboom, Deparcieux, Quetelet, Süssmilch, and others), and the third part deals with the calculation of mortality rates. \*New Palgrave III,p.55.

This is a further elaboration of the principles of railroad economics developed previously in the author's seminal *Mathematische Begründung der Volkswirtschaftslehre* (1885), a significant contribution to marginal economics, and his *Theorie des Trassirens* (1887-88). Launhardt started his career as a civil engineer and became professor at the Technical University in Hanover, and its first rector. As a specialist in the technology and economics of road and railway transportation he gradually applied his insights to more general problems of transportation networks.

First edition. Launhardt started his career as a civil engineer and became professor at the Technical University in Hanover and its first rector. As a specialist in the technology and economics of road and railway transportation he gradually applied his insights to more general problems of transportation networks. His fame as an economist is chiefly based upon his *Mathematische Begründung der Volkswirtschaftslehre* published in 1885. That work gave Launhardt a prominent place in the history of economic analysis. It largely represents principles taught also by Jevons and Walras, but Launhardt's claim that it was based upon independent research seems justifiable, particularly if one considers its genesis.

The work of Wilhelm Launhardt is characterized by J.Niehans as 'Germany's most important and in fact only significant contribution to the 'marginal revolution' in the last three decades of the 19th century. In the economic analysis of transportation and location, this contribution was not surpassed until the 1930's. Available only in German, some of it in publications that are hard to find, it still has not found the recognition it deserves, and Schumpeter's references ... are inadequate'.

The present work on the *Theory of network planning* consists of two parts. The first part on 'commercial network planning', a much revised and enlarged version of an earlier publication (*Kommerzielle Tracirung der Verkehrswege*, 1872), contains the derivation of efficiency criteria without regard to topography. The second part on 'technical network planning for railroads' applies economic efficiency criteria to curves and gradients imposed by topography.

'The contribution to economics are found in part I. This begins with a discussion of investment criteria. From a social point of view, networks should be planned in such a way that the sum of operating and capital costs is a minimum. Private capitalists, however, try to maximize the internal rate of return on their capital. Under perfect competition the two criteria would coincide, since the internal rate of return, if duly maximized, would equal the market rate of interest. In reality, however, since the railroad industry is inherently non-competitive, rates of return can be pushed above market rates of interest by keeping railroad investment below the social optimum. This was one of Launhardt's basic arguments for government ownership of railroads.'

First edition, rare. Friedrich List's seminal advocacy of economic nationalism, derived from the nationalist and romantic ideas of Alexander Hamilton and Adam Müller, from whom List also adopted his opposition against the ideas of Adam Smith. List considered the principle of free-trade detrimental to the national interest, to which the immediate interests of groups and individuals should be submitted. To List the nation was an entity whose aim is not the creation of wealth by international exchange, but the development of its own economic and productive sources. 'These views coincided so exactly with the reawakening of German nationalism that Lists's book caused a great sensation when it was published, and it remained for seventy years the theoretic gospel of the advocates of protectionist tariffs in Germany, Britain and the United States.'

First edition. The major book on economics of the author, professor of history and politics at the Brunswick Carolinum. Lueder was among the first to lecture Smithian economics in Germany and hence played an important role in the development of German economics from mercantilism to liberalism. The present work is largely a paraphrase of the *Wealth of nations*, yet it has been noticed that Lueder deserves a place in the history of economic literature on his own account for the numerous corrections and additions to the work of Smith, particularly where geographical, ethnographical, agricultural and statistical issues are discussed, and for his emphasis on the influence of moral and intellectual factors on industrial development.

First edition. An important book because it introduced liberal economic principles in mid-nineteenth century Italy, and a remarkable book because it was written when the author was 22 years old. Palgrave calls it 'considering the date when it was written, a very noteworthy work'.

Scialoja advocated economic principles largely following the ideas of the English economists. He 'stoutly upheld the principles of liberty, at a date when Naples was the stronghold of absolutism and protection', he asserted the importance of mathematics in economic researches, referring to a.o. Canard, etc. The book was highly successful, reprinted several times and translated into French.

Scialoja studied law at Naples and pored over the works of the older Italian and foreign economists. In 1846 he was appointed the first professor of political economy in Turin. Scialoja soon became involved in the political events of the Risorgimento, which brought him imprisonment and exile. He became a major figure in the development of its liberal economic and financial policy, serving as a minister of finance, agriculture and education in successive revolutionary governments.

Schumpeter describes him as 'a man of conspicuous brilliance', yet his book as 'nondescript ... however very well written and correspondingly successful', and wonders 'what could a man have done who was able to accomplish such a feat in the absence of politics, public service, and so on, all interspersed with imprisonment, exile, cabinet office'.

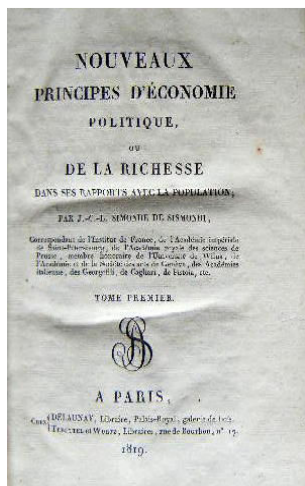

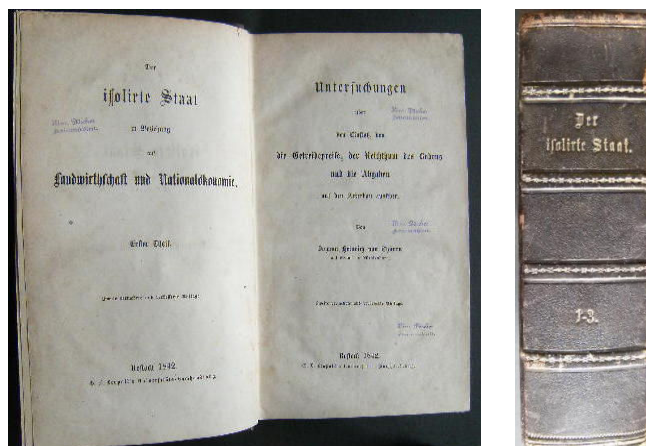

First edition. One of the earliest scientific treatises on banking. It was published posthumously by E.D.Ebeling, and only the introductory general treatise on banking (p.1-152) was completed by Büsch when he died the previous year. The other essays treat banks throughout Europe, i.a. the banks of Hamburg, Venice, Amsterdam and London, and specific aspects of banking, like the function of the 'Girobank' (transfer bank), a 'single monetary standard' to introduce in the whole of Europe, thus anticipating the euro, etc.

Büsch was professor of mathematics and director of a trade academy at Hamburg. An economist by experience and observation rather than by study, he became the author of a considerable number of works on commerce 'of much greater value than the wordy compilations of Büsch's in his time more famous forerunner J.P.Marperger' (W.Roscher).

As a theoretical economist Büsch advocated liberal principles and free trade, 'though not without mercantilist errors', and for this as well as for other reasons his work has been regarded as an anticipation of Friedrich List's 'national system of political economy'. Büsch was critical to Adam Smith, whom he considered over-estimated, and favoured James Steuart, as so many other German economists of his time did.

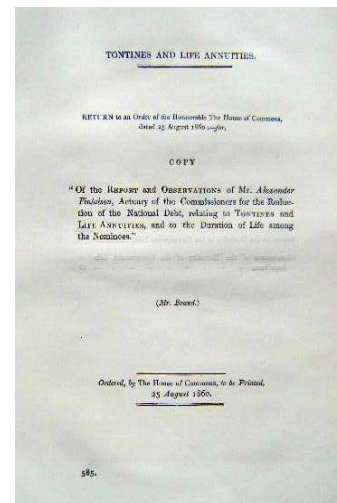

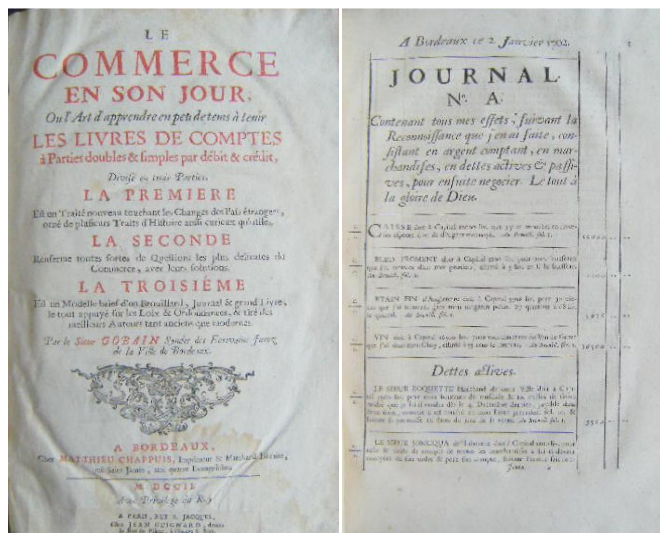

First (only) edition, rare. The first book of 'the golden age of French accounting books in Bordeaux', preceding Jean Moulinier's *Grand trésor des marchands, banquiers et négocians* by two years. It is both a treatise on the commerce with foreign countries and a treatise on double-entry book-keeping. It is divided into three parts. In the first part Gobain explains the various terms used in commercial transactions and gives examples of letters of exchange. He then explains the exchange with foreign countries: Holland, England, Danmark, Sweden, Danzig, Hamburg, Spain, Portugal, Rome, Venice, the Levant, Turkey, the Americas, etc. He adds concise histories of these countries and advices for merchants that want to do business with foreign nations. In the second part (starting with p.105) Gobain gives 'very-useful' examples of the way various transactions should be recorded using double-entry book-keeping: purchases, sales, insurances, interests, transactions made in company, etc. The third part details about a memorial kept in Bordeaux from 2 January until 8 June 1702, to which numerous auxiliary books are added. The Committee, presided by Labouchere, presented this voluminous report, but unfortunately it did not result in the introduction of the suggested improvements.
